

Defensive and Competitive Bidding

Overcalls (Style; responses: 1/2 level; reopening)

General Style = Aggressive NV

Reponses: Jump Raise = NF

Cue-Bid = SUPP Limit or +; 2NT with or without jump= "Jacoby-ish"

New Suit = F1

1NT overcalls (2nd/4th live; responses; reopening)

2nd Position = 15 - 18

Responses: System On

4th Position = 11 - 14

Responses: Natural ; cue bid: Stayman

Jump Overcalls: (Style; responses; unusual NT)

1-suit: weak

2-suit: 2NT minors

Reopen: 2NT = 19-20

Direct and Jump cue Bids (Style; responses; reopen)

(1m)-2m: Majors 8-15

1M)-2M: other Major and a minor 8-15

Vs NT (vs Strong/weak; reopening; pH

Multi Landy

Vs preempts (doubles, cue-Bids; jumps; NT bids

Vs Artificial Strong Openings

Over Opponents take out double

1M-(DBL)-2M-1: Good 2M, 2M: worse (one under)

RDBL: 10+
